



The final lesson of each unit is a test on the word list for that unit. We also have an answer available for each workbook. The list price per workbook is \$8.95 and \$3.00 for each answer key.

OUR DISCOUNTS

Christian Liberty Press provides Christian schools with a substantial discount. We give schools a minimum of a 40% discount on the purchase of our publications. This discount applies *only* to books and other products produced by **Christian Liberty Press**. Such items include "**CLP**" as part of their product number. The terms and conditions for establishing an account so that you may obtain such discounts are found on the next page.

Items that are purchased by schools are not subject to our normal 30-day return privilege. All shipping or freight charges are the responsibility of the schools. Payment by check or money order must be made payable to Christian Liberty Press.

Prepaid Accounts

To establish an account that qualifies for a 40–50% discount, we require the following:

- ▶ All materials published by **Christian Liberty Press** qualify for a 40% discount in quantities of below twenty-five (25), which may include any combination of titles. A 50% discount is available when schools purchase twenty-five (25) or more copies of the *same* title that has a **CLP** prefix.
- ▶ The first order must include a total of at least ten (10) items published by Christian Liberty Press and prepay with a check, money order, MasterCard, VISA, or Discover Card. There is a \$20.00 service charge for every returned check.

Delayed Billing Accounts

To establish a net-30 account with a 40-50% discount, we require the following:

- ▶ Send in your first prepaid order containing a total of at least twenty (20) Christian Liberty Press publications, which may include any combination of titles. Please include fifteen percent (15%) of your subtotal for shipping and handling your first order. All future orders will be charged exact shipping costs. You may take advantage of any of our standard discounts with your first order. Prepay with a check, money order, MasterCard, VISA, or Discover Card.
- ▶ Include a letter with your first prepaid order listing the names of at least two organizations that we may contact to verify your credit history.
- ▶ Net-30 schools will have thirty days from the date their book order was shipped to remit their payment.
- ▶ We reserve the right to hold shipments for schools with past due balances. Accounts that are consistently delinquent will not continue to enjoy a delayed billing privilege.

Purchasing non-CLP Titles

Christian Liberty Press also distributes materials from a number of other companies, including such well-known educational publishers as Modern Curriculum Press, Bob Jones University Press, Saxon, and Alpha-Omega. Most of the products from such companies found within this catalog may be ordered by schools but please note the following:

- ▶ Due to a policy established by A Beka Book, we are unable to sell A Beka materials to schools.
- ▶ Titles that do not have a prefix of "CLP" shall **not** be discounted and shall not be ordered on a delayed billing basis.
- ▶ Schools that desire to order non-CLP titles must order them on a separate prepaid basis.



Trottino s Tale




